Type of wine:	Red wine made with organic grapes
Grapes:	Petit Verdot – picked by hand
Vintage:	2021
Alcohol content:	14% vol.
Fermentation:	Traditional fermentation
Aging vessel:	Stainless steel tank and French oak barrels
Origin/location:	100% estate grown in our Sanel Valley Vineyards/Hopland, the southernmost town in Mendocino County
Soil:	Mostly gravely, bench land loamy soils
Altitude:	500-600 feet above sea level
Age of vines:	Vines plots of 26, 29 years old
Case production:	168

Tasting notes: Distinctive purple color. Medium-high aroma complexity. Features layers of fruit, dark core of cherry, licorice as well as baking spices, black pepper and hints of juniper and chocolate. A full-bodied wine, velvety with a nice and long persistence.
